The following checklist is vital for any workplace which has lift trucks on the premises. Each of these questions must be answered with "yes" if all the safety regulations and rules are being followed. A "no" to whatever question indicates a procedural weakness which could lead to accident, injury or damage to machinery.

- 1) Is the forklift operating area separated from pedestrian traffic?
- 2) Is access by pedestrians to forklift areas restricted by a barrier?
- 3) The walkways for pedestrians are well-marked?
- 4) Are "forklift in operation" signs visibly clear?
- 5) Are mirrors for pedestrians and drivers provided at blind spots?
- 6) Alterations or changes to the daily forklift schedule has been communicated to workers?
- 7) The forklift tires being utilized are suitable for all operating surfaces?
- 8) Is the seatbelt being utilized?
- 9) The forklift seat is in good condition?
- 10) The maintenance schedule of the forklift is being followed?
- 11) Are annual checks of the forklift being carried out?
- 12) Is the type of forklift appropriate for the job?
- 13) Does forklift has a readable load chart?
- 14) Do all operators understand how to read the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for various uses and attachments?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work correctly?
- 17) Is the operating speed control device fitted correctly?
- 18) The lift truck overhead cage is fitted correctly?
- 19) Have all lift truck operators acquired certification?
- 20) Are warning signs and speed limits being observed?
- 21) Are lift truck operators up to date on training for all kinds of lift trucks being utilized?
- 22) Forklift operators understand their responsibilities to report the damage to the machine and other forklift accidents?
- 23) Is the pre-test checklist reviewed daily prior to the equipment being used?
