Courses also consist of Material Safety Data Sheet (or MSDS) training. Even though not related directly to the use of a lift truck, MSDS training is vital if an operator damages a container containing toxic materials, or notices a leaking container. MSDS sheets list the products, their effects on individuals and correct methods of handling spills.
